10 tips to Nail Your Headshot

#1 Breathe Deeply: Take a moment to inhale and exhale slowly before stepping in front of the camera. This simple practice will help you feel more relaxed and comfortable and ready to shine in your headshots.

#2 Stand Tall & Relaxed: Showcase your best posture by keeping your spine straight and shoulders comfortably down.

#3 Angle Your Body: Turn your chest 10 to 45 degrees away from the camera and lean slightly towards it.

#4 Shift Your Weight: If standing, lean on one foot towards the camera to create a relaxed and engaging stance. When sitting bend forward at the hips .

#5 Find Your Superstar Angle: Experiment with different angles. Tilt your head slightly, move nose to left and right and explore various positions that enhance your best qualities.

#6 Define Your Jawline: Extend your forehead slightly and chin down slightly to create a more defined jawline.

#7 Engage the Camera: Engage your eyes by looking directly into the camera lens as if you're having a delightful conversation with it. Think of something exciting or happy to bring a natural twinkle.

#8 Express Yourself: Experiment with different expressions to convey a range of moods and emotions. From genuine smiles to subtle smirks or serious gazes, find what aligns with the purpose of your headshot.

#9 Play with Hand Placement: Be mindful of where you position your hands within the frame. You can rest them gently on your lap, fold them, put them in pockets, on hips, or incorporate props if appropriate.

#10 Practice Makes Perfect: Spend time practicing your poses and expressions in front of a mirror to familiarize yourself with your best angles and features. This will help you feel more comfortable and confident during the actual headshot session.
